[#] Influenza vaccine is recommended in the *NHRMC Australian Immunisation Handbook, 9th Edition* for children >6mths & adults with underlying medical risk factors and those wishing to reduce likelihood of influenza illness. **The vaccine is not funded in NSW for these groups.**

^{oo} If no previous vaccine in past 10years.

[^] Eligible & provided free if patient born after 1966 and has not had two doses of MMR vaccine. No serology required.

NIPPI; These vaccines are funded under the National Indigenous Program for Pneumococcal & Influenza Program for all Indigenous Australians 50yrs+ and those identified as “at risk” from ≥15 to 49years.
